The WaterWorks Centre nature reserve is perfect for bird watching across old filter beds with plenty of bird hides - look out for Teal in winter with their stunning green eye strip and yellow bottom.

Explore Leyton and Walthamstow Marshes this large nature reserve is grazed by cattle in the summer and is home to one of the largest remaining ancient wetland meadows in the capital.

The open spaces and nature reserves on Lea Bridge Road offer miles of traffic free, well surfaced pathways ideal for taking a leisurely stroll. Download a route, explore on your own or come along on one of our guided walks.

Lea Bridge Road

Look out for:

Water Voles – although often elusive, look for signs of their habitat, such as burrows, nibbled vegetation or piles of small cylindrical poo.
