Lee Valley Regional Park's coarse angling venues include 27 gravel pits and 17 stretches of river/flood channel that gives anglers 24 different venues to choose from. Of these venues 11 are directly managed by the Fisheries department, 12 are licenced to angling clubs, societies and consortia and one is jointly managed. 
The website also has news, catches and helpful information, particularly waiting list places and season permit availability.

## STANSTEAD INNINGS

SG12 8HL (TL 386114)

**Adult:**  
£370

Stanstead Innings is one of the jewels in our fisheries portfolio! The complex comprises of 3 gravel pits Abbotts Lake, Banjo Lake and Stock Pit totalling just under 33 acres. Abbotts Lake contains a cracking head of specimen Carp topped by the stunning 'Chub Common', Banjo Lake has benefitted from a proactive stocking programme and contains between 150-200 Carp between 10lb and 30lb and Stock Pit contains some stunning looking Carp. All the swims are comfortable and constructed to a very high standard and good access is available.

Current record weights: Common Carp 52lb 3oz; Mirror Carp 41lb; Bream 16lb 6oz; Perch 3lb; Pike 18lb; Tench 14lb.

Currently a waiting list operates for this venue.



## GLEN FABA CM19 5JW (TL 397086)

This is a mature gravel pit of just over 67 acres with natural, grassy banks and swims. The lake is a maze of gravel bars, islands, points and bays with silty depths of 25 - 30ft in many places, hence location is the key to catching. Stocked Carp introduced in 2010 have been caught at over 45lb and the lake has some cracking commons! Access around the lake can be difficult due to excess water, muddy terrain and uneven surfaces.

Current record weights Mirror Carp 47lb 8oz; Pike 26lb.

Currently a waiting list operates for this venue.



## ADMIRALS WALK EN11 8AB (TL 375079)

Admirals Walk is a quiet 25 acre open gravel pit with natural banks and informal swims. There are numerous underwater features including gravel bars, gullies and dense submerged weed beds. This fishery is a Day Only Season Permit venue. Access around the lake can be difficult due to excess water, muddy terrain and uneven surfaces.

Current record weight: Mirror Carp 40lb 8oz.



## NAZEING MEADS EN9 2PB (TL 388071)

This permit consists of three large settlement lagoons for the Lee Flood Relief system totalling 125 acres, plus Brackens Pool which is a small enclosed gravel pit of 2.5 acres. The main lagoons and Brackens Pool are typical gravel pits containing numerous underwater features. Due to recent high demand it has been necessary to introduce a waiting list for this venue.

Current record weights: Mirror Carp 47lb 6oz; Bream 17lb 4oz; Chub 7lb 12oz; Eel 8lb 1oz; Perch 3lb 12oz; Pike 30lb; Tench 12lb 2oz.

Currently a waiting list operates for this venue.



## SLIPE LANE PITS EN10 6EX (TL 372050)

This venue comprises of four gravel pits, Lea, Railway, Marsh and Boot Pit, consisting of 25 acres in total. These waters are jointly managed by Lee Valley Regional Park and Turnford Angling Consortium where you can join any of the members clubs.

Current record weights: Mirror Carp 46lb; Bream 11lb; Eel 6lb 1oz; Pike 27lb; Tench 12lb.

Permits for this venue can be purchased directly from the Fisheries department.



## ASHLEY EN8 0LU (TL 363036)

Ashley is a picturesque 16.5 acre gravel pit with a host of underwater features in every swim including gravel bars, plateaus, gullies, weed beds and islands. The swims are large, formal and constructed to a very high standard.

Current record weight: Mirror Carp 41lb 4oz.

## NORTH MET PIT EN8 0LU (TL 363036)

This is a mature gravel pit of 58 acres divided into two. The main body of the lake is approximately 45 acres with the northern section covering around 13 acres. A large pipe running under a causeway allows the fish to move freely between the two areas. Both lakes are a maze of gravel bars, islands, points and bays hence location is the key to catching. The rewards for getting location and tactics right can be phenomenal!

Current record weights: Mirror Carp 48lb; Crucian Carp 4lb 4oz; Bream 10lb 12oz; Pike 30lb; Tench 10lb 2oz.

## BOWYERS WATER EN8 9AJ (TL 366023)

This 35 acre mature gravel pit is the oldest fishery in the park's portfolio. It's an ideal fishery for anglers looking for a challenge. Uncluttered banks and superb head of specimen Carp make this a very special venue. This water is full of features such as gravel bars, plateaus, islands and large beds of lily pads.

Current record weight: Mirror Carp 42lb 12oz.

Currently a waiting list operates for this venue.



## WALTONS WALK AND CORNMILL STREAM EN9 2PB (TL 376004)

The Waltons Walk section of Lee Flood Relief Channel from Highbridge Street to David Stoker Sluice offers a large number of swims varying in sizes to suit both specimen and general anglers. Pole fishing is not permitted due to overhead power cables. The Cornmill Stream section runs from the Stoney Bridge area to Gatehouse Bridge within Waltham Abbey Gardens. The bank directly adjacent to Abbey Farmhouse is out of bounds.

Current record weights: Mirror Carp 32lb; Bream 11lb; Chub 8lb; Perch 3lb 15oz; Pike 24lb 11oz; Roach 2lb 3oz; Tench 8lb; Barbel 16lb 2oz.
